


Mark, seal, and sign your envelope




1. Mark your ballot

• Follow the directions on the ballot.



2. Seal your envelope

- Check that you have the return envelope with your name on it.
- Put your ballot into the ID envelope and seal the envelope.



3. Sign the envelope

- Date and sign your name on the back of the ID envelope in ink.
- Print your name and Orange County Residence Address, as it appears on your registration affidavit.

4. Options for returning your ballot



BY MAIL

- Place your voted ballot in the ID Envelope provided.
- Your ballot must be postmarked on or before Election Day and received no later than 7 days after the election.



BY FAX

- Complete the ID Envelope and Oath of Voter form.
- Fax your ballot, Oath of Voter form and ID Envelope to (714) 567-5100.
- Our office cannot accept your faxed ballot without the Oath of Voter form and the ID Envelope. Your faxed ballot must be received by 8:00 p.m. Election Day.

Important additional infol

- Ballots received by email will not be accepted.
- Please be sure to allow for sufficient time to either fax or mail your ballot back to our office.
