




Every voter marks a paper ballot


Chain of custody for voted ballots

#### REDISTRICTING

In late-2021/early-2022, State, County and local jurisdictions redrew boundaries of each of their districts. Redistricting is required every 10 years following the U.S. Census.

### **NO PARTY PREFERENCE**

If you're registered as a No Party Preference voter, your ballot will not include Presidential candidates unless you request a party ballot. The American Independent, Democratic, and Libertarian Parties allow No Party Preference voters to crossover and vote for their Presidential candidates. All other parties require No Party Preference voters to re-register with their party to vote for their Presidential candidates.
